COURSE OVERVIEW

This unit offers a comprehensive introduction to safe work at heights, maintaining safety at work, performing work at heights, an understanding of the hierarchy of prevention of falls and clean up requirements. This unit is a necessary qualification for those working in roles where they are required to perform work at heights over 2metres above ground (measured from the feet) or 1.5metres below a surface.

Training consists of a face-to-face theory session followed by hands-on practical training. Practical training is performed on a purposely built heights safety simulator which is suitable for domestic and commercial heights training. The simulator offers a versatile range of heights safety systems to cater for all industries.

This unit largely focuses on a practical training approach to ensure learners are well equipped to safely perform work at heights.

COURSE OUTCOME

The successful learner will be issued with a nationally recognised *Statement of Attainment* and *Competency Card*.
