COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Must be over the age of 14
- Must provide three (3) forms of identification, further info provided at time of enrolment

COURSE APPLICATION

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work.

This unit meets the general construction induction training requirements of:

- Part 1.1 Definitions and Part 6.5 of the Model Work Health and Safety Regulations;
- Division 11 of Part 3 of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 for Western Australia; and
- Division 3 of Part 5.1 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007 for Victoria.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The unit requires the person to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others.

Content includes but is not limited to; identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.

DELIVERY OPTIONS

This course **must** be delivered face-to-face in Queensland subject to the exemption for students residing in a rural area who may receive training delivered electronically via online delivery. A rural area is considered 100 kilometres or more from any RTO offering face-to-face delivery of this unit.

COURSE OUTCOME

The outcome of this unit for those deemed competent, will be a nationally recognised training Statement of Attainment to Prepare to work safely in the construction industry.
